





STUDENTS BY GEOGRAPHICAL ORIGIN











HIGH SCHOOL QUINTILE PROFILE (EXCLUDING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)



DISTRIBUTION OF UNDER- AND POSTGRADUATE ENROLMENTS BY QUALIFICATION TYPE










DISTRIBUTION OF UNDERGRADUATE ENROLMENTS BY QUALIFICATION TYPE






