



Poverty

330 million women and girls live on less than US \$ 1.90 a day.(UN)

Data

Only 37% of confirmed cases were classified under age and sex.
(UN WOMEN)

women :

- 70% of workers in health services worldwide
- 80% of nurses and nursing assistants.
- Health professionals

Contamination: Women is 3 X > than men
